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
Mark position of holes in post mount onto post.
Remove fixture base (A) and set aside.

1. Carefully fixture base (A) down over top of post.

4. Drill a 3/16" hole at each marked location on post.

Allow fixture base (A) to sit on post.

- 5. Strip 3/4" of insulation from ends of fixture wires.
- 6. Twist end of fixture ground wire (bare copper) and end of house ground wire (copper) together. Twist wire nut (C) onto ends of wires. Completely tighten wire nut (C).
- Twist end of house lead wire (black) and end of fixture lead wire (black) together. Twist wire nut (C) onto ends of wires. Completely tighten wire nut (C). Twist end of house neutral wire (white) and end of fixture neutral wire (white) together. Twist wire nut (C) onto ends of wires. Completely tighten wire nut (C).
- 8. Wrap electrical tape (not included) around wire nuts (C) and wires. Ensure wires are securely fastened into wire nuts.



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- 9. Carefully push wires down into post.
- 10. Place fixture base (A) down over post. **DO NOT** pinch wires between post mount and post.
- 11. Align holes in post mount with holes in post.
- 12. Thread one fixture mounting screw (E) into each hole in post mount and into post. Tighten fixture mounting screws (E) to secure fixture to post.
- 13. Screw recommended bulb (E26 Edison bulb type, not included) into socket. Verify correct bulb wattage marked on socket of fixture. **WARNING:** DO NOT exceed maximum bulb wattage.
- 14. Place cage (B) down over bulb. Fit bottom of cage (B) into fixture base (A).
- 15. Thread one thumbscrew (D) into each hole along fixture base (A). Equally tighten each thumbscrew (D) to secure cage (B) in place. DO NOT over tighten.
- 16. Place roof (F) down on top of cage (B).
- 17. Thread one thumbscrew (G) into each hole along roof (F). Equally tighten thumbscrews (G) to secure roof (F) in place. DO NOT over tighten.

MAINTENANCE NOTE: Only use a soft damp cloth to clean fixture as needed. DO NOT use harsh chemicals on fixture. Harsh chemicals may damage fixture.

Coastal conditions may cause mineral and residue build-up on fixture. It is recommended that customers in coastal areas clean all external surfaces of fixture once every two weeks with a wet cloth.
